

MINUTES  
GHS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION MEETING  
NOVEMBER 7, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Jenny Nichols. Motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to take 25 prints to the alumni ladies' luncheon on January 14 to sell.
5. Reunion. Briefly discussed reunion committees. We will again utilize Firehouse Subs for the food. Kim has stored away some of the decorations we need to use and Regina will coordinate registration. Also discussed contacting teachers to attend. All of this will be more fully covered at the next meeting which is December 5.
